About the Exhibition

The Yorke Peninsula (YP) Art was first held in 1999 over the October longweekend and then moved to the Easter long-weekend and a biennial event in 20002. Previously Coordinated by a Section 41 Committee of the Yorke Peninsula Council, the Exhibition is now coordinated through a volunteer and staff Working Party to plan, support and promote creativity and the arts within our community.

Due to Covid restrictions imposed in 2020, the Exhibition will celebrate its 11th year in 2021 and move back to its Biennial rotation from this year.

The Yorke Peninsula Art Exhibition is a major cultural event on the beautiful and iconic Yorke Peninsula. The exhibition attracts a wide variety of entrants from across the state and provides the perfect addition to an Easter break on Yorkes for locals and visitors alike.

A regionally inspired art exhibition, the diverse art programme includes local schools / school students and is held at three key venues – Ardrossan (fine art / painting), Edithburgh (sculpture) and Yorketown (photography). In addition, we have a number of public art and mural projects also worth visiting as part of the YP Art Trail. Adding even more opportunities to experience and meet the wide range of art and artists (of all ages) on the Yorke Peninsula.

Through art and creativity, Council is committed to attracting visitors to rural areas and less visited attractions and locations, as they continue to promote our region as a desirable holiday destination –that is less than two hours from Adelaide. The Working Party recognises that artists and business entrepreneurs make an important contribution to Australian society, the economy and assist in driving tourism by providing creative approaches to regional development.

The YP Art Exhibition has won two SA Great Regional Awards for Art in 2006 and 2008, an Advantage SA Award in 2010 and were admitted into the Hall of Fame in 2010 for recognition of "outstanding achievements and significant contributions demonstrating excellence in regional leadership".

Our diverse exhibition program and support continues to grow. It includes strong involvement from local schools and students, as well as attracting well-known and new artists across the region and the state.
